Dear Parents/Carers,


We would like to remind families that when students have a medical appointment during the school day, they are expected to attend school both before and after the appointment wherever possible.

The school is only able to authorise absence for the time of the appointment itself, along with reasonable travel time. If an appointment is scheduled for part of the day, students should return to school promptly once it has concluded, and attend school beforehand if the appointment is later in the day.


All medical appointments must be requested in advance by emailing absence@thecooperschool.co.uk and attaching a copy of the appointment confirmation. Without this information, we may be unable to authorise the absence.
